People of the Book

Sura 2:177 It is not righteousness that ye turn your faces toward East or West; but it is righteousness to **believe in Allah** and the **Last Day** and the **Angels** and the **Book** and the **Messengers**; to spend of your substance out of love for Him for your kin for orphans for the needy for the wayfarer for those who ask and for the ransom of slaves; to be steadfast in prayer and practice regular charity; to fulfil the contracts which ye have made; and to be firm and patient in pain (or suffering) and adversity and throughout all periods of panic. Such are the people of truth the Allah-fearing.

Sura 3: 113 Not all of them are alike: of the **People of the book** are a portion that stand (for the right); they rehearse the signs of Allah all night long and then prostrate themselves in adoration.

Sura 3: 199 And there are certainly among the **people of the Book** those who believe in Allah in the revelation to you and in the revelation to them bowing in humility to Allah: they will not sell the signs of Allah for a miserable gain! for them is a reward with their Lord and Allah is swift in account.

Sura 5: 68, 69 Say: "O People of the Book! ye have no ground to stand upon unless ye stand fast by the Law the Gospel and all the revelation that has come to you from your Lord." It is the revelation that cometh to thee from thy Lord that increaseth in most of them their obstinate rebellion and blasphemy. But sorrow thou not over (these) people without Faith. (69) Those who believe (in the Qur'an) those who follow the Jewish (Scriptures) and the Sabians and the Christians any who believe in Allah and the Last Day and work righteousness on them shall be no fear nor shall they grieve.

Sura 6: 161, 162 Say: "Verily my Lord hath guided me to a way that is straight a religion of right the path (trod) by Abraham the true in faith and he (certainly) joined not gods with Allah." (162) Say: "Truly my prayer and my service of sacrifice my life and my death are (all) for Allah the Cherisher of the Worlds:

Sura 10: 94, 95 If thou wert in doubt as to what We have revealed unto thee then ask those who have been reading the Book from before thee: the Truth hath indeed come to thee from thy Lord: so be in nowise of those in doubt. (95) Nor be of those who reject the Signs of Allah or thou shalt be of those who perish.

Truth from the word of God enters the hovel of the peasant; rays from the Sun of Righteousness light up the rude cottage of the poor, bringing gladness to the sick and suffering. Angels of God are there, and the simple faith shown makes the crust of bread and the cup of water a banquet. The sin-pardoning Saviour welcomes the poor and ignorant, and gives them to eat of the bread that comes down from heaven. They drink of the water of life. Those who have been loathed and abandoned are through faith and pardon raised to the dignity of sons and daughters of God. Lifted above the world, they sit in heavenly places in Christ. They may have no earthly treasure, but they have found the pearl of great price. {7T 227} [Reference Genesis 21:14 Hagar & Ishmael were given spiritual understandings of salvation when cast out]

- Sura 2:101 And when came to them an Apostle from Allah confirming what was with them a party of the **people of the Book** threw away the Book of Allah behind their backs as if (it had been something) they did not know! 102 [good note]
- Sura 3:3 It is He Who sent down to thee (step by step) in truth the **Book** confirming what went before it; and He sent down Law (Of Moses) and the Gospel (of Jesus) before this as a guide to mankind and He sent down the Criterion (of judgment between right and wrong). 344 345
- Sura 3:98 Say: <u>"O people of the Book!</u> why reject ye the signs of Allah when Allah is Himself witness to all ye do?
- Sura 3:99 Say: "O ve People of the Book! why obstruct ye those who believe from the path of Allah seeking to make it crooked while ye were yourselves witnesses (to Allah's Covenant)? But Allah is not unmindful of all that ye do." 426
- Sura 3:100 O ye who believe! if ye listen to a faction among the **People of the Book** they would (indeed) render you apostates after ye have believed!

Sins before hand to judgment

Sura 20:74 Verily he who comes to his Lord as a sinner (at judgment) for him is Hell: therein shall he neither die nor live. 2597

Sura 16:25 Let them bear on the Day of Judgment their own burdens in full and also (something) of the burdens of those without knowledge whom they misled. Alas how grievous the burdens they will bear! 2048

Sura 3:77 As for those who sell the faith they owe to Allah and their own plighted word for a small price they shall have no portion in the hereafter: nor will Allah (deign to) speak to them or look at them on the Day of Judgment nor will He cleanse them (of sin); they shall have a grievous penalty. 412 413

Sura 43:61 And (Jesus) shall be a Sign (for the coming of) the Hour (of Judgment): therefore have no doubt about the (Hour) but follow ye Me: this is a Straight Way.
